



WELCOME ACTIVITIES FOR THE SPRING TERM

Tuesday the 12th of January

Arrival day: *In Nymble (the student union building) from 1000 - 2000*

ISS welcomes all new students to KTH, with snacks, buns, soda and coffee. The students will also be receiving their welcome packages, which include essential information, and a functional SIM card. KTH Accommodations will be open for business, and students can pick up their apartment keys.

Wednesday the 13th of January:

KTH Campus Tour: *Gather at Nymble 1200*

We will gather at the student union building for some “freshman” orientation around the main campus. Some sections will have a private campus tour including some of your own unique locations.

Introduction Meeting from KTH: *Hall F1, Lindstedtsvägen 22, Campus Valhallavägen 1400-1630*

We will be meeting in room F1, you can find it on the main campus map in front of the info center. Light introduction to KTH with a half hour break at 1500.

Thursday the 14th of January

City Rally: *Gather at Nymble (the student union building) at 1200*

Saturday the 16th of January:

Boule: *Gather at Nymble, 1st group at 1000, and 2nd group at 1200*

We have booked enough place for 100 students to participate, the cost will be 30 SEK (Swedish crowns) each. Due to the limit, a sign up sheet is needed as well. ISS will be introducing a great Swedish tradition to the new students. Since the sauna is only big enough for 30 people, so we will have to divide the students into several groups. Therefore, a sign up sheet is necessary for this activity.
